INFORMATION SHEET

“In Stitches” Workshop in Transferring Designs onto Fabric, with Artist in Residence, June Heap, at the D-Day Museum, on Saturday 2 May 2009, 1pm – 3pm

This session will provide an opportunity to try out two basic ways of transferring existing drawings onto fabric, ready for future stitched works. We will explore the method of “Pricking and Pouncing” used by the Royal School of Needlework embroiderers, to prepare for the panels for the Overlord Embroidery, plus transferring computer images, using heat transfer paper.

All materials will be provided, but you need to bring:

- Simple line drawings (**A4 size or smaller**) to try out the different methods (if you did the basic drawing session with me – **bring your drawings!**) and/or
- **Postcards or photographs** to use as starting points. **NB please do not bring images on CD-rom or Memory Stick.**
- **Paper and pen**, for any notes you may want to make.

Also bring if you have them:

- **Favourite needles and threads** for a quick stitch at the end, if we have time! (Some threads will be provided)
