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### INFORMATION SHEET

**“In Stitches” Workshop – “Machine Embroidery for Improvers”  
with Artist in Residence, June Heap, at the D-Day Museum,  
Clarence Esplanade, Southsea PO5 3NT  
on Wednesday 6 May 2009, 6pm – 8pm**

An exploratory session for those people who have a basic skill and knowledge of machine embroidery, but who wish to develop their confidence and technique by working on soluble fabrics- (one of the methods I am using during my Residency at the Museum).

#### **Please Note:**

- Bring a **sewing machine**, capable of being used for free-stitching. You also need to bring a **darning foot** for your machine. (Bernina sewing machines are very good for machine embroidery and are the ones I use. If you bring another make, you must know how to thread it and use it for straight and zig-zag stitching.)
- Whatever the make, please bring extra **needles and bobbins**.
- NB We have a small number of Bernina machines available for use. These are available on a first come, first served basis and can be booked by phoning Portsmouth City Museum on 023 9282 7261 – say you are phoning about “In Stitches”).
- Bring any **drawings/images** (including postcards, photographs) you may wish to try out. I will also supply some design ideas developed from the Overlord Embroidery in the D-Day Museum.
- Machine embroidery threads will be provided, but in a limited number of colours. If you have any **machine embroidery threads of your own**, please bring them.
- Bring **paper and pen** to take notes.
